Know the Signs

Recognizing hearing loss is the first step towards improving quality of life. Symptoms of hearing loss may include:

- Finding speech sounds mumbled.
- Hearing but not understanding speech.
- Asking people to repeat themselves.
- Trouble hearing women's or children's voices.
- Trouble understanding conversations in groups or background noise, such as in a restaurant or car.
- Avoiding social situations that were once enjoyed.
- Having to turn TV/radio up louder than others would prefer.
- Tinnitus or noises in the ear.
